Dear Student

We are reaching out to let you know of the changes in the classes and other Centro Comunitario CEUS programs due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

CEUS, like other organizations, has been deeply impacted by the pandemic. Our offices have been closed since the middle of March and our employees now work from home.

As you know, we cancelled the last three weeks of the Winter semester of English and Spanish literacy classes. We had previously planned to begin the Spring semester on April 26, but we have postponed that start date due to the continuing limitations on movement and social gathering enacted by the State of New Jersey due to the virus.

We will advise you if we arrive at a situation that classes can resume. At present, however, it appears that it will be some while before groups of people can get together again safely.

Despite the difficult situation, CEUS's legal team continues to offer immigration legal services, and we continue to provide support for the immigrant community. We are looking at all of our programs to see how we can offer support to immigrants through use of the internet and social media. We also are launching a Spring fundraising campaign to help ensure that CEUS can survive through these difficult times.
